## THE PROBLEM

A significant number of Kind at Heart clients rely on wood-burning stoves or fireplaces to warm their homes in the winter - particularly those living in trailers in the rural parts of our community. In fact, many go through 4-5 ricks of wood (or more) during the cold season, and we work hard to ensure they don't go without. Too often we've found that when the wood is gone, our Neighbors burn anything they can find to keep warmth. Unfortunately, this "solution" only creates more problems, i.e., the creation of toxic build-up in their homes/bodies and potential damage to stove/pipes.

## THE SOLUTION

Community members can help these Neighbors in a few ways, both tangibly and financially: 1) Provide a rick of wood to a Neighbor in need; 2) Donate \$ to Kind at Heart to purchase wood; 3) Volunteer to split wood that's been donated; and/or 4) Provide wood to be split into firewood on our property.
