Mary, 86, often jokes that she, along with her son and daughter, have created their own family "rest home."

Her son John, an amputee, is a former roofer who has struggled with debilitating pain ever since he fell from a roof many years ago. Her daughter Mary Ann relies on a cane for stability as she moves throughout the house.

But it was Mary's need that first prompted the call to Kind at Heart. She had broken her hip after falling off of her porch and was so "paralyzed by fear" that she refused to see the doctor for follow-up appointments. She was afraid she would fall again trying to leave the house.

Upon initial assessment, it became pretty evident that any service or support we provided would be a "help multiplied." Little did we know just how far that impact would extend beyond Mary.

By the time we were done with the project, a local church—already looking for a way to help Mary and her family—would be rolling up its sleeves to help build a ramp. And Mary's next door neighbor would end up with a wheelchair ramp of her own.
