

DEAR FRIEND & CHAMPION,

IndaMae was in desperate need of help when she first learned about Kind at Heart through a local referral agency. She had been struggling with mobility impairment since a stroke in 2023, and showering was nearly impossible.

Upon assessing her needs for a walk-in shower and ADA toilet, it became apparent that she was at high risk of a catastrophic fall-related injury.

In addition to her bathroom renovation needs, a growing hole in her front porch presented a risk every time she exited or entered. And her split level home required a sort of "acrobatics" that someone with a walker (or three in her case) shouldn't have to perform to navigate between rooms.

THERE IS NO WIGGLE ROOM FOR HOME REPAIRS. INDAMAE HAS ALREADY REFINANCED HER HOME MULTIPLE TIMES JUST TO HAVE A LITTLE EXTRA MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS.

Our new "Neighbor" is just one of many seniors 65+ who are facing a daily, uphill battle to simply maintain the status quo. But loneliness, poverty, and disability are major barriers to "quality of life."

25% of adults 65+ are socially isolated.

This increased risk of loneliness is due to declining health, personal loss, and living alone.



10% of seniors 65+ live in poverty.

This number is even higher among Kind at Heart clients; estimated to be around 37%. Nearly 80% live at 200% of the federal poverty level.



40% of those 65+ are impacted by a disability.

Mobility, self-care, cognition, and hearing & vision challenges all impact quality of life.


