We would like to thank you for your partnership with Kind at Heart Ministries for our 3rd Annual Fundraising event, a luncheon, on October 22nd, 2019. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO HOST A TABLE?

Hosting a table doesn't cost a thing . . . just your investment of time into filling a table of 8 people (including yourself). "RISE" is a fundraiser, so there WILL be a time to give at the event; however, that amount is up to the discretion of each attendee.

WHO SHOULD I INVITE?

Consider your friends, family, coworkers - anyone who loves this community and has the potential to champion the Kind at Heart mission through financial support, volunteerism, and/or spiritual battle.

WHAT KIND OF COMMUNICATION CAN I EXPECT FROM KAH?

In addition to sending an email or two prior to the event, we will be confirming guests & tables starting October 1st. We would ask you to confirm attendance with your guests prior to this date, if possible.

DO YOU HAVE ANY GOALS FOR THIS LUNCHEON?

In addition to raising \$60,000 (about 1/3 of our budget), we hope to see a RISE in the number of champions for our growing number of clients.

WHAT WILL I HAVE TO DO ON LUNCHEON DAY?

Help us create a positive atmosphere for event guests by welcoming the individuals at your table and collecting donation envelopes at the appointed time. We would also LOVE for you to spread the love on social media and tag us and your friends!
